SIRIUS Courses

SIRIUS courses represent a textbook replacement model and are designed to be taught in any delivery mode—face-to-face, hybrid/blended, or fully online. Courses are developed by teams including faculty, instructional designers, multimedia specialists, editors, external, nationally-known content consultants, and quality assurance staff. All content and pedagogy are developed by the teams. Emphasis is on the development of highly creative, interactive courses making use of the latest research in learning, motivation, and technology. **SIRIUS courses are designed to provide high quality interactive course materials at low costs to students. The courses are published and distributed by McGraw-Hill Learning Solutions.**

Twenty high enrollment/high student demand courses have been developed as SIRIUS courses through Spring Term, 2009. **Courses available for Fall Term, 2009 include Strategies for Success in College, Career and Life; Reading Skills; Introduction to Composition; English Composition I; English Composition II; Introduction to Literature; Humanities: The Foundations; Fundamentals of Speech Communication; Elementary Algebra; Intermediate Algebra; College Algebra; Elementary Statistics; Life in its Biological Environment & Lab; General Psychology; Human Growth and Development; Human Relations in Business and Industry; Introduction to Sociology; U.S. History to 1865; Principles of Economics I; and World Religion.** Each course includes a custom-developed book, a CD, and an online course shell.

Faculty Development

The *Online Professor Certificate* training program is provided online and hosted and taught by Florida State College faculty. A certificate is provided to all program completers.

Developing Interactive Online Courses—15 hours. Basic orientation to online pedagogy/andragogy. Includes an introduction to instructional design and uses of mastery, cooperative and constructivist learning and learning communities.

Blackboard Academic Suite—12 hours. (Optional as appropriate for institutions)

Multimedia—6 hours. Basic applications of multimedia to online instruction, including identification, development and use of learning objects.

Mentored Learning Experience—a total of 9 hours mentored online teaching experience.

Serving as Mentor—following serving as a Mentee, faculty serve as a Mentor for 9 hours during one term for other faculty who are completing the training leading to the Certificate.
